THE ACADEMIC CENTRES

- Macro Planning Centre .

The S. G. is to help Director General in executing financial and administrative affairs.

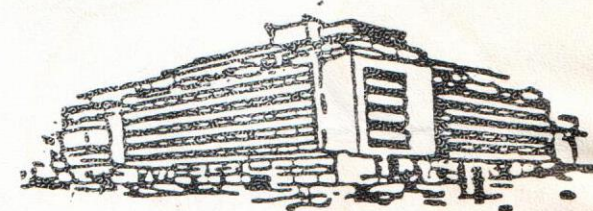
MORE ABOUT INP
